March 1: Renew your current room.

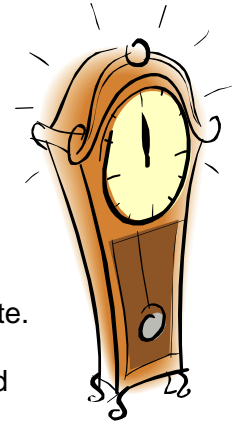
March 8: If you renewed your room, hold an empty space in your suite for suitemate/roommate.

March 15: Reservation times begin, assigned according to your application date.

March 29: Open reservations - You can complete your housing application and continue to reserve any room without waiting for a reservation time.

March 1 - July 27: You may change your room reservation.

May 9: Reservation times begin, assigned according to your application date.

May 24: Open reservations - You can complete your application and continue to reserve any room without waiting for a reservation time.

CHANGING ROOMS

After you have reserved a room, you can change your room, optional services (bed lofting, refrigerator rental, and bike storage), early bird move-in, and meal plan as many times as you like until midnight on July 27. On July 28, your information will be frozen in order to prepare for move-in day, August 17.

Room Freeze: There is a two week room freeze at the beginning of each semester. Room changes can be requested **after August 31** (move may begin one week after the freeze) by obtaining and filling out a room change request form from your RA. No moves may take place until authorized by Housing & Residential Education. There is a fine for unauthorized room changes.



MEAL PLAN CHANGES

Beginning on move-in day, you have the first two weeks of the semester to change your meal plan. You may only change your meal plan once each semester. The last day to change your meal plan for Fall semester is August 31.

WITHDRAWING OR CANCELLING RESERVATION

If your plans have changed and you will NOT be attending The University of Utah, cancel your reservation by informing Housing & Residential Education in writing to info@housing.utah.edu. Your withdrawal is not final until you have received an e-mail confirmation.

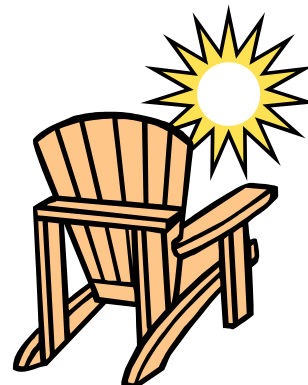
If you are still going to attend the University of Utah but no longer wish to live on campus, you must cancel your reservation **on or before July 27, 2007 or you will need to pay the cancellation fee of \$400.00.**

BENCHMARK PLAZA

To be eligible to live in Benchmark Plaza, you must have at least 60 credit hours. Your AP and test credits do not count towards the 60 required credits. Housing U will calculate your credit hours and include credit hours for classes you are registered for in Spring and Summer, 2007.

SUMMER '07 INFORMATION

- **March 1:** Summer housing application available.
- Must be registered for Summer classes to live on campus.
- Summer housing will be in buildings 813, 820, 822, and an Officers Circle house (for those eligible to live on Officers Circle). If you will be here for Summer 2007 and the 2007-08 academic year, we encourage you to reserve the same summer and academic year room. This will eliminate the need to move during the Fall stay over period.



SUMMER '07 INFORMATION Continued...

- **April 15:** Last day to cancel Summer housing reservation.
- **May 7:** Payment due for Summer housing and meal plan.
- **May 11:** Move-in day for Summer.

SPRING 2007 STAY OVER:

Only available for Spring semester residents attending Summer session.

- **April 1:** Spring stay over housing application available.
- **May 5:** Last day to sign up for stay over without penalty.
- Residence hall residents - stay in your room for stay over; then move to building 813 during the week of May 7. **YOU MUST BE AVAILABLE TO MOVE WHEN REQUESTED TO DO SO.**
- Benchmark Plaza – stay in your room for stay over; then those in building 821 will move to either building 820, 822 or the Officers Circle house for the summer. Moves will take place during the week of May 7. **YOU MUST BE AVAILABLE TO MOVE WHEN REQUESTED TO DO SO.**
- Officers Circle – stay in your room for stay over; then everyone will move to the designated summer house. Moves will take place during the week of May 7. **YOU MUST BE AVAILABLE TO MOVE WHEN REQUESTED TO DO SO.**
