Your room rate includes internet access, cable TV access and all utilities. Rates are subject to Board of Trustees approval.

(Utility rate increases granted by the Public Service Commission may result in an increase to the room rates listed above. You will receive 30 days notice of any planned increases to room rates.)

Residence Hall Association (RHA) Dues: \$ 46.40 per year. All residents are members of the Residence Halls Association. Dues are added to your account at the beginning of the semester. Dues are non-refundable.

Payment Options:

Do not send payments through campus mail.

- 1) Log into Housing U and make payment online
- 2) Call 801-587-2002 to make payment with a credit/debit card.
- 3) A 24-hour drop box is located just inside the HRE office entry door. Drop your check in the box with your student ID number on your payment.
- 4) Come into the HRE office during business hours to pay with cash, check, money order, debit card, credit card, traveler's check or UCard.

Payment Information

- 1) You can view your account information online in Housing U. It is the students' responsibility to keep the account up-to-date.
- 2) A payment is considered late if it arrives in HRE after the due date or is paid on line after the due date.
- 3) Past due accounts will be assessed a \$20 late fee on the eighth day of each month the account is past due and has a balance greater than \$20. Failure to pay will result in a registration HOLD being placed on your University records and transcripts.
- 4) All checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a minimum \$20 charge. All collection fees necessary to close or bring the account up-to-date will be assessed to you.

Important Dates to Know

Students must cancel their contract by the cancellation deadline or pay the **\$400.00** contract cancellation fee.

FALL DATES

August 21	First-Time Resident Move-In Day! Residents check in after 9 am. Dinner will be provided for students and their parents.
August 22	Move In day for returning students. Residents check in after 9 am. Meal plan begins.
August 21-24	Residence Hall Association/HRE sponsored opening activities and events.
August 25	Classes begin, all residents must be checked in. If you expect to arrive late, you must notify HRE in advance.
October 13-17	Fall Break, no classes, residence halls remain open. Meal plan service is available during break.
November 27-29	Thanksgiving Break, no classes, residence halls remain open (no meal plan service).
December 20	Halls close at 2 pm. Only students signed up to stay over the Winter break may remain (no meal plan service).

SPRING DATES

January 9	Move In Day! New residents check in at the HRE Office after 9 am. Meal plan begins. Returning residents can return to their Fall room.
January 12	Classes begin, all residents must be checked in. If you expect to arrive late, you must notify HRE in advance.
March 16-21	Spring Break, residence halls remain open (no meal plan service).
May 9	Halls close at 2 pm.

Early Arrival (Available August 17-21)

Early arrival housing is available only for students who need to move in early for approved University sponsored activities or requirements. Contact HRE Office for more information. You will be charged a pro-rated daily rate.

Winter Break Stay Over

The Winter break is not part of the academic year contract. Students wishing to stay over for the break will need to complete a separate agreement in Housing U and make payment before the break begins. Only residents continuing for Spring Semester may sign-up for Stay Over.



Required Meal Plan

Residents of Officers Circle, Gateway Heights, Chapel Glen, and Sage Point are required to purchase a meal plan. Meals are dine-in and are served in the Peterson Heritage Center on an all-you-care-to-eat basis. **You may eat as many meals per day as you wish.** A week starts on Thursday and ends on Wednesday. Unused meals do not carry over from week to week. **Failure to use the meal plan does not cancel the student's financial responsibility for paying for the meal plan.**

Your U-Card (ID card)

Your U-card serves as your meal card. Present your card upon entering the dining facility. Meals may only be eaten by the card owner.

Transfer Meals (Transferability)

Transferability allows you to eat (transfer) one meal daily at the Union food court, Heritage Center Crimson Corner or Crimson View. Students are allowed a per diem value of \$5.60 towards any meal. Purchases over this amount are to be paid by the student. Transferring more than one meal per day may result in a financial penalty.

Flex Dollars

Flex dollars are declining balance funds that can be used for meals or snacks at any Chartwells retail location on campus. See www.dineoncampus.com/utah/ for a list of locations and hours. Any flex dollars remaining at the end of the fall semester will be carried over to the spring semester.

Changing Your Meal Plan - (once per semester)

You may change your meal plan the first week of each semester. Students must email info@housing.utah.edu to request a meal plan change. Meal plan change requests will not be accepted any later than 5pm on the date listed:

Last day to change your meal plan for Fall Semester: August 29, 2008.

Last day to change your meal plan for Spring Semester: January 16, 2009.

Commuter Meal Plans
