Electronic Agreement Policy

University Convicted Sex Offender Policy

The University has determined that convicted sex offenders pose a clear and present danger to residents living in student housing. The University also compares each applicant for student housing against the Utah Sex Offender Registry. Known convicted sex offenders are not permitted to live in student housing.

Alcohol and Drug Policy

The possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, including beer, are prohibited by University and state regulations anywhere on the University of Utah Campus including Heritage Commons. Alcohol is not permitted in any outside area adjacent to the Residence Halls.

Possession of alcohol in these areas described above will result in University disciplinary action, fines, and may result in arrest by the University Police Department.

Possession, use or distribution of illegal drugs, including narcotics, is prohibited. Any resident who is in violation of this policy may be expelled from the University, fined, and prosecuted under state and/or federal laws.
